Attached is a map I received from Matt Berg, our contractor, who found Eurasian water milfoil (EWM) again on our lake. The map shows the areas where he found EWM on July 3rd. The rooted plants were removed by Matt and Dave Blumer, our other contractor, will be discussing treatment options for the bed in the west basin.

When you are boating on the lake, watch for floating fragments. You may also see them near your docks or on shore. Please remove them and discard them on land. Let me know when and where you find fragments. If you are in doubt whether what you see is EWM, take a picture and send it to me or a board member. If you see submerged plants that look like EWM in other areas also report those to me or a board member.

The good news is that Matt could not find any EWM in the area that was treated last year.
